Areas of accompaniment

In the indigenous context:

- distribution of the Bible and its message in the Toba, Pilagá and Mocoví languages
- Biblical training
- Coordinating the Toba and Pilagá teams translating and recording the Scriptures
- Valuing the indigenous languages and studying them
- Resource and counsel pastoral leaders
- advocacy for a self-governing church of the indigenous peoples
- publication of the bulletin Qad'aqtaxanaxanec (Nuestro Mensajero), since 1955, distributing it to more than 250 indigenous congregations in the chaco area
- counseling and help for recuperation of indigenous lands
- visitation of aboriginal peoples in hospitals, jails, and homes
- compile indigenous testimonies and oral histories
- pastoral visits in churches

in the non-indigenous context:


- promotion of a vision of integral and interdenominational evangelization through visits, presentations and literature—in part in cooperation with the Interconfessional Meeting of Missionaries.
- sharing the ways God is working amongst the indigenous churches


Our Vision
